Raynor Garage Doors verifies the Raynor garage doors listed below are an Eligible Building Envelope Component, which may qualify for a Federal Tax Credit under the Energy Improvement and Extensions Act of 2008 (H.R. 1424), signed into law Oct. 3rd 2008. Tax Credits are available for years 2006, 2007, 2009, and 2010 but not for 2008.

Note that all models are eligible in all climate zones.

Any of the doors specified above, with up to one full row of insulated windows, still qualify for the Federal Tax Credit under the Energy Improvement and Extensions Act of 2008. Please note STS is not available with insulated glass.
